

AFFIDAVIT OF ORIGIN**TO: THE U.S. COAST GUARD and/or TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:**

The undersigned, Bailey Taplin, was Production Manager for the WESTSAIL CORPORATION from March, 1972 until June, 1974 while the Company was located in Costa Mesa, California.

He was directly responsible for the construction of the WESTSAIL 32 sailboats from Hull No. 37 through Hull No. 200, and at the time he left employment of the WESTSAIL CORPORATION in June of 1974, there were approximately 200 more vessels on order.


All of the Westsail 32 boats were made from fiberglass molds made from the same tooling plug, and all boats are identical in length, beam and depth. All major components of the hull and superstructure were made of materials manufactured in the United States, and all suppliers of material were located in the United States.

The dimensions and specifications of the vessel are as follows:

Number of decks - One, Contour of Stem - Curved, Shape of Stern - Sharp, Length 32 - 0/10 feet, Breadth 11 - 0/10 feet, Depth 8 - 7/10 feet, Gross Tonnage 15.31, Net Tonnage 13.00.

This affidavit is verification that the Westsail 32 auxiliary sailboat, with the Hull Number 85, Manufacturers HIN WSSK 0085 0273, was constructed using a hull and deck built by the WESTSAIL CORPORATION in Costa Mesa, California during 1973, and sold as a HULL KIT to the original owner.

The WESTSAIL CORPORATION ceased operation in 1982, and is no longer in business.
